White Cliffs Caravan Park update

The White Cliffs Caravan Park has a new caretaker. The caravan park is owned by Central Darling Shire Council and managed by the White Cliffs Community Association.

White Cliffs is a popular tourist destination. Visitors come to explore the great outdoors, see the heritage power station, hear about opal mining and underground living, plus plenty more. The free Central Darling Heritage Trail driving tours are also popular. While the White Cliffs Hotel is another destination standout – named the AHA NSW Best Bush Pub in 2023.

The White Cliffs Caravan Park offers a total of 46 sites. There are 25 powered sites available, 20 unpowered and 1 cabin.

As part of the movement to a new caretaker an online booking system is now in place for the caravan park. The reason for an online booking system is to limit cash handling and reduce the need for a caretaker to be onsite for extended periods. It is also expected that travellers will benefit from the convenience of online booking as they can plan ahead of their arrival.
